All dogs competing in Agility will be required to present an official AKC Jump Height Card prior to running in an Agility Trial. All dogs **except those jumping 24" and 26" (unless a VMO or AKC Rep is present)** without permanent or temporary height cards will be measured. **If you have a height card, please submit a copy with your entry. TRIUNE AGILITY CLUB WILL ACCEPT PHOTOCOPIES OF THE PERMANENT OR UNEXPIRED TEMPORARY HEIGHT CARD WITH THE ENTRY FOR THIS SHOW.**

OBSTACLES

Please see the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for current list of Mandatory Obstacles. Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained AKC ILP/PAL numbers, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Breeds not registerable with the AKC are NOT eligible to enter. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION

There will be NO contact obstacle familiarization for Novice dogs. (AKC Rule effective 9/1/06)

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

These trials will be held indoors in two 100' x 100' ring with rolled packed dirt floor. There is plenty of close parking, crate space and restrooms. Please bring chairs, crates, and water for your dogs and clean up tools.

Due to safety reasons, no flexi leads will be allowed to be used in the building or within 50 feet of the building

BUILDING WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR SET UP on WEDNESDAY, February 10, 2010 from 5 p.m. to 7 pm. X-pens are not allowed due to close crating. Please stack crates when possible. No ground cloths will be allowed unless hidden totally under crates. No saving of spaces with chairs or tables.

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Bitches in season are not permitted in the Trial. No refunds for bitches that come in season after the closing date.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$23 charge added on returned checks. No refund for duplicate entries. Care will be taken to find duplicates, however, if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.

Entry fees will not be refunded if the trials cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee be asked to leave the trial site. There will be no refund of entry fees if a person is asked to leave the trial site.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

Exhibitors alone are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. Failure to be at ring gate could result in the exhibitor being marked absent.

Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Dogs under 6 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Agility Trials.

The Triune Agility Club of Greater Lawrence does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
