Day-to-day move-ups will be accepted at the trial. Move-ups must be submitted on the move-up form provided, to the trial secretary no later than 30 minutes after completion of the last class of the day.

Online vs Paper Entry Primary Limits:

TACL is accepting online entries for this trial through the AKC Agility Online Entry Services. Go to www.akc.org/AgilityEntry and follow the instructions there to use your "My AKC" account to enter this event online. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online entries or paper entries will be as follows: Online Entries: 33% Paper entries: 67%. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or paper limits accordingly.

Paper entries received within 24 hours of the opening date & time limit must:

- 1) Include postage or be metered. No hand deliveries in the first 24 hours.
2) Be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postage or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS & DHL. If above conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to the sender.
3) Express mail must be designated "no signature required".

**** MEASURING ****

Jump Height Information: All dogs without height cards will have to be measured by the judge of record, except 24"/26" dogs. If a VMO or an AKC Representative is available, all dogs without height cards, including 24"/26" dogs, will need to be measured. When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dogs on the Dogs To Be Measured List. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

OBSTACLES

Please see the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for current list of Mandatory Obstacles. Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are register-able breeds that have obtained PAL/ILP numbers from the American Kennel Club, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. All American dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program are eligible to enter this all-breed AKC agility trial. Mixed breed dogs entered in these events must list the breed name as "All American" and not as a breed hybrid and must include their AKC Canine Partners number on the entry form and check the AKC No. Box.

Any abuse of the grounds will be brought to the attention of the trial giving club and it's Trial Committee. Any exhibitor's entries may be refused for previous misuse of the motel facilities. This is an AKC supported measure.

FOOD

There will be a concession stand on site where food will be available for purchase at reasonable prices. In addition, there are fast food restaurants and sit-down restaurants within 1 minute of the show site.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

These trials will be held indoors in two 120' x 90' soccer turf. Facility is Air conditioned. There is plenty of close parking, crate space and restrooms. Please bring chairs, crates, and water for your dogs and clean up tools.

BUILDING WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR SET UP on THURSDAY, September 2, 2010 from 5 p.m. to 7 pm. 7:30 a.m on Friday and 6:30 a.m. on Saturday, Sunday and Monday. **X-pens are not allowed. Flexi Leads are not allowed in the building or within 50 feet of the building.** Crating will be offered on a large basketball court and in marked areas around the arena and on the field. Crate mats or tarps are required under crates on basketball court and on field.

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Bitches in season are not permitted in the Trial. No refunds for bitches that come in season after the closing date.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$23 charge added on returned checks. No refund for duplicate entries. Care will be taken to find duplicates, however, if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.

Entry fees will not be refunded if the trials cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee be asked to leave the trial site. There will be no refund of entry fees if a person is asked to leave the trial site.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

Exhibitors alone are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. Failure to be at ring gate could result in the exhibitor being marked absent.

Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Dogs under 6 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Agility Trials.

The Triune Agility Club of Greater Lawrence does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of Record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs entered in the **AKC Canine Partners Program** may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option effective April 1, 2010. These dogs should list the breed as All American Dogs listed dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.
